- Exit at Harrison/Rybolt (exit 11)
- Left on Rybolt Rd.
- Immediate Right on Harrison Ave. -Travel 1.5 miles
- Right on Wesselman (by UDF) -Travel 1/2 mile
- Nathaniel Greene Lodge is on the right

From I-75 (Best from downtown or southern):

- West on I-74
- Exit at Harrison Ave. (Exit 11)
- Left On Harrison Ave.
- Travel 1.6 miles
- Right on Wesselman (by UDF)
- Travel 1/2 mile
- Nathaniel Greene Lodge is on the right

- State Route 4 to Boymel, turn right on Boymel,
- Turn right at second entrance into parking lot

From Middletown, Monroe, or West Chester:

- State Route 4 to By-Pass 4 South
- Turn Left on SR 4 to Boymel, turn right on Boymel
- Turn right at second entrance into parking lot

From Oxford:

- US 27 South to I-275 East
- Take exit 41, SR 4 to Boymel, turn right on Boymel
- Turn right at second entrance into parking lot

From Cincinnati:

- Take I-71 or I-75 North to I-275 West
- Take exit 41, SR 4 to Boymel, turn right on Boymel
- Turn right at second entrance into parking lot

Take I-275 E towards OH-32
Merge onto OH-32 via EXIT 63B toward Batavia
Turn Right onto Eastgate Square Dr. (You will see Biggs, Frisch's, HHGregg... you are going behind Biggs)
Turn Left onto Aicholtz Rd.
The Civic Center is on your left
The Queen City Room is downstairs

From 71 N/S or 75 N/S around Downtown Cincinnati :

Take I-471 S toward I-275/ Alexandria
(This is crossing into Kentucky via the "Big Mac Bridge")
Merge onto I-275 E via EXIT 1A on the left toward Columbus -OH (Cross back into Ohio)
Merge onto OH-32 E via EXIT 63B toward Batavia
Turn Right onto Eastgate Square Dr. (You will see Biggs, Frisch's, HHGregg... you are going behind Biggs)
Turn left onto Aicholtz Rd.
The Civic Center is on your left
The Queen City Room is downstairs
