Dr. Gary Smith is an Associate Professor of Pediatrics at the Ohio State University College of Medicine and Public Health and the Director of the Center for Injury Research and at Nationwide Children's Hospital in Columbus, Ohio. In addition to his clinical training, Dr. Smith holds Master of Public Health and Doctor of Public Health degrees from the Johns Hopkins University School of Hygiene and Public Health. He is chairperson of the national Committee on Injury, Violence, and Poison Prevention of the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP), chairperson of the Committee on Injury and Poison Prevention of the Ohio AAP, and is a member of the injury research study section of the National Center for Injury Prevention and Control of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

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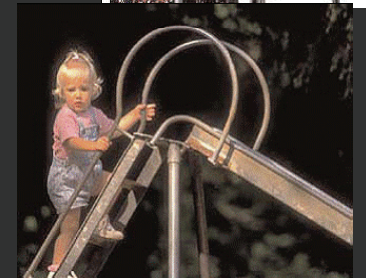
